You are required to submit a **Cover Letter (up to 250 words)** outlining:

1. Why you are interested in surgery and/or surgical education.
2. Relevant experience and skills.
3. Ideas you would like to implement as MD1 Representative.

You are also required to submit a **current CV (up to one A4 page)**.
